ARTICLE VI

ELECTIONS

*SECTION 1. Nominations to the Oakdale Sportsmen's Club Board of Directors shall be made by the General Membership writing a nominee's name in a blank section provided on the dues form, which all members receive in the October Golden Pheasant. **in October and November before the Board Meeting in November. Members wanting to be on the ballot shall present themselves to the Board of Directors or to the membership at the October or November***

***Dinner meeting to in order to be placed on the ballot.***

*The President shall appoint an election committee of not less than three members to screen the nominated members and present a ballot to each Oakdale Sportsmen's Club Member at the annual December meeting. The names of the members running for the Board of Directors shall be placed on the ballot by Draw.*

***Ballots will be passed out and voted on at the December meeting.***

***Candidates on the ballot will also be given time to speak to the membership at the December meeting before the Vote. Write-in candidates shall present themselves at the December Meeting prior to ballots being passed out.***

*Nominated Members to the Board of Directors must be Present at the December Club Election Meeting to be considered for Office.*
