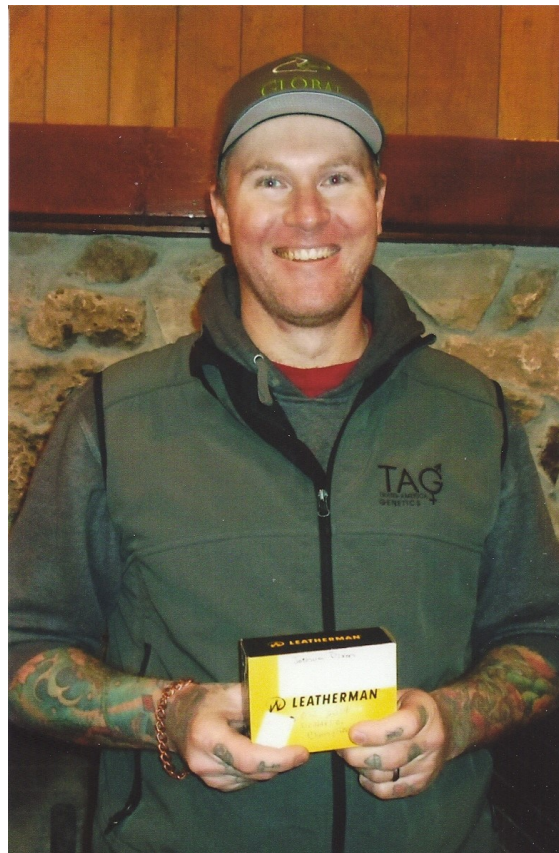
Lastly, Valentine's is on Saturday February 14th, No excuses, you have been warned! Do something nice for your sweetie.
