**NEW RULE!** All shooters must sign in before using Rifle or Pistol Bays. The sign in sheet will be located in the Rifle Bench area.

**Shooting is now allowed without an RSO when the gate is shut and you use your gate key card to open the gate. You must sign in. See and read the range rules posted. Remember that camera and video surveillance has been increased. If the gate is open there must be an RSO present before any shooting is allowed.**

**Other info:** A member was recently suspended and subsequently resigned his membership after shooting a high powered rifle in pistol bay 1. You have all received and acknowledged

receipt of the range rules and agreed to abide by them. Recognize that safety of the club and members is the most important issue at hand. If we intend to keep OSC as a "gun club" then the rules must be adhered to. If you value your membership, abide by the rules!
